Critical reading is an ironic name because this section is not about reading but understanding the 3 question types and where they are found in the passage. Students can generally skip reading 70% of the passage and still get every answer right.

In this section most students pick an answer on what sounds good, but that will probably yield a wrong answer. Finding the correct answer is knowing the key elements in the sentence that point you to the answer.

The DVD goes over each section of the SAT/PSAT and shows the shortcuts and strategies as well as trick answer choices. The students will work actual questions in the workbook and then I go back over each question and show the students why each answer is right and why the other four are wrong. This teaches them to critically think through each answer choice so they are not tricked by the wrong ones.

After taking this class students will know what to expect on the SAT and PSAT. On test day there should be no surprises!

Common Sat Myths

When you purchase (*HIGHLY RECOMMENDED*) the 2nd edition College Board “Official SAT Study Guide” for the class homework, there are 3 myths (on the back cover) that seem to contradict my program so I will explain my opinion below in case you are asked:

Myth #1 - The SAT is a logic test.

Truth: The SAT is a “reasoning” test, which is stated on the front of the actual test booklet. “Reasoning” is the process of forming conclusions, judgments, or inferences from facts or premises using thinking that is coherent and logical. The SAT examines a student’s critical thinking skills and his or her ability to logically deduce solutions to problems. No, there are no syllogisms or actual logic problems, but the format of the test is designed to demonstrate a student’s ability to use logic.

Myth #2 - Tips and shortcuts can help you ace the SAT.

Truth: SAT questions are not straightforward; they are confusing and intended to mislead students. Extremely smart students (AP, honors, even Valedictorians) often bomb the SAT because of the confusing language of the test. The Tips and Shortcuts taught in *College Prep Genius* are designed to help students sift through the word problems to discover what the question is actually asking. There is no cheat sheet for the SAT, but there are strategies and methods that can help students get more answers right and achieve higher scores.

Myth #3 - Short term prep is the best way to boost score.

Truth: In no way can a “prep course” replace years of solid schoolwork. However, a student’s dedication to rigorous coursework does not always guarantee a good SAT score. Oftentimes, an SAT/PSAT prep class can be extremely beneficial for “good” students because it can familiarize them with the test and elucidate some strategies to managing the time constraints and the confusing language.

There is no instant success. In order to really solidify the information learned in a prep class (whether short or long), students will need to study for at least 3 months before an actual test by taking practice exams from The College Board materials. While students should strive to maintain a good GPA, they should also incorporate preparation for the SAT which is testing their critical thinking skills on math, writing and critical reading.
